When paired with the Bushnell Golf Mobile App, the Wingman HD delivers visible and audible GPS distances along with powerful, immersive audio and a large color screen-helping you stay connected to your game while enjoying your favorite music on the course.

This Owner's Guide is designed to help you get the most from your Wingman HD by explaining its key features, benefits, and proper care. We encourage you to review these instructions before your first round so you can maximize performance, extend product life, and fully enjoy the experience of having Bushnell innovation by your side.

CONNECTING YOUR WINGMAN HD TO YOUR MOBILE DEVICE & BUSHNELL GOLF MOBILE APP

To connect your Wingman HD to your phone and the Bushnell Golf Mobile app:

- Download the Bushnell Golf mobile app at app.bushnellgolf.com/install or scan the QR code.
- If you are new to the app, you will be asked to set up a device after registration and select Wingman HD. As a returning user to the app, select "See All" from "My Devices", click "Add Device", and select Wingman HD from the list of Bushnell Golf devices.
- Follow the app's on-screen instructions to pair and connect your Wingman HD speaker.



Note: After pairing, the Bluetooth on/off state will be the last set state once powered up.

POWER UP & BLUETOOTH™ SPEAKER OPERATION

- 1. Connect the provided USB-C charger to the USB-C input port at the bottom to charge Wingman HD's internal lithiumion battery.
- 2. To see the battery's charge, see the top right of the screen. A red battery bar on the screen indicates low power.
- 3. The USB-A input/output port can recharge your phone or other accessories. Note: Using the Wingman HD to recharge mobile devices will reduce the speaker's battery level and operating time.
- 4. To turn the speaker on, press and hold the "B" button for at least 4 seconds, until the startup sound is heard and the screen appears, and release.
- 5. To pair the device with a mobile phone, ensure the Wingman HD is within 10 meters/32 feet from your device. Then, register and pair the device with the Bushnell Golf Mobile App for complete functionality of the Wingman HD. Refer to the "Connecting Your Wingman HD to Your Mobile Device and the Bushnell Golf Mobile App" instructions above.
- 6. To connect to Bluetooth, press the "B" button twice to enter pairing mode. The Bluetooth icon will appear on the screen. Go to the Bluetooth settings in your device and select "Wingman HD Audio" to pair. Follow the prompts to continue to connect to Bluetooth.
- 7. The Wingman HD has a microphone that allows you to take incoming calls. To answer an incoming call, press the Play button. To reject an incoming call, Press and hold the Play button. To end a call, press Play.

Note: when powered on, the speaker automatically reconnects to the last mobile device it was paired with. The speaker can memorize up to 8 paired devices and will shut off after 15 minutes in pairing mode if no devices have been paired. This is a power-saving feature.

CONCERT LINKS OPERATION

The Wingman HD's Concert Links technology enables you to play two Wingman HD speakers with the same audio simultaneously. To activate Concert Links and listen to audio with mutiple Wingman HD units:

- 1. Place the two speakers near each other (the distance should not be over 10 meters/32 feet).
- 2. Power on both speakers. Press and hold the Play button on speaker for three seconds to enter into Concert Links Mode. Go through the same procedure for the second speaker.
- 3. Alternatively, Swipe Up on the FCB Home Screen. Press the Concert Links icon one both speakers.
- 4. "Concert Links ON" will be displayed on the speakers if they are connected correctly.
- 5. To disconnect the Concert Links connection, press the Concert Links icon on the Utility screen or power off either speaker.

FCB Concert Link

Note: When two speakers are tethered in Concert Links mode and in a round of golf, the main speaker will be the only speaker to display information on the screen.

INDOOR/OUTDOOR EQ MODE

This electronically equalizes the speaker's tonal balance for optimum listening quality when used indoors (clubhouse/home) or outdoors (golf course). Indoor Mode provides a fuller, richer sound. Outdoor Mode carries sound further to be heard at a distance.

Simultaneously press the Volume Up and Volume Down buttons to toggle from Indoor/Outdoor Modes. Note: The Wingman HD default mode is Indoor.





- 1. Turn on the Wingman HD by pressing and holding the "B" Button. Open the Bushell Golf Mobile App.
- 2. If the device has been paired to the Wingman HD "Connected" will be soon then, press "Play Golf".
- 3. Find your course, press to open a round. Follow the instructions on the app.
- 4. Once a game has started on the app, the Wingman HD will show the hole information and you're ready to PLAY GOLF!

GAME PLAY ACTIONS

ENTERING THE HOLE SCORE

- 1. To enter the score for the hole, press on the score on the top right of the Front/Center/Back or Hole View screens.
- 2. The Score screen allows the player to enter the score for the hole. If the score is less than three or more than eight, press on the three dots (...) and enter the score manually.







USING THE SCORECARD

- 1. To access the Scorecard screen for the round, press on the score on the top left of the Front/Center/Back screen.
- 2. The Scorecard screen allows the player to enter or correct any scores for the game.





SHOT DISTANCE

- 1. Swipe Up from the Front/Center/Back screen to access the Shot Distance screen.
- 2. Press the Play icon to start the Shot Distance calculation.
- 3. Drive or walk to the ball.
- 4. Press Pause to stop the Shot Distance calculation.
- 5. To reset, press the Reset icon.

MyBag is a collaborative effort between Foresight Sports and Bushnell Golf, designed to generate real time personalized club and PlayAs recommendations based on current conditions at your location. The MyBag feature enables players to create and share personalized club assessment data across the Foresight Sports and Bushnell Golf environments, for use in the Bushnell Golf App. This technology represents a leap forward in distance measurement and personalized, data-driven performance enhancement for golfers of all levels.

Create a MyBag Profile

- 1. To use MyBag technology, you will need a Bushnell Golf Mobile App account and a Foresight App account.
- 2. Create a MyBag club set using your account on the Foresight App. The app will take you through the setup process of hitting shots in the Foresight Sports environment to establish your personal MyBag club set.
- 3. Log in to your Bushnell Golf Mobile App, and from the Account screen, link your Foresight Sports account to import your MyBag club data.
- 4. Register your Wingman HD to your Bushnell Golf App from the homepage via Bluetooth and begin to receive personalized PlayAs distances and club recommendations.

PROGRAMMABLE WINGMAN HD BUTTONS

The Wingman HD has the capability of programming the "B" button and the "O" softkey. This is done by acessing Settings in the Bushnell Golf App.

- Bushnell (B Button) Soft Key: Choose what function you would like to progam the B Button to perform: Golf Annoucements, Score Entry Screen, Scorecard View, Shot Distance Screen, or Hazard Screen. Press Set to save choice.
- Virtual (O) Soft Key: Choose what function you would like to progam the B Button to perform: Golf Annoucements, Score Entry Screen, Scorecard View, Shot Distance Screen, or Hazard Screen. Press Set to save choice.

CHARGING THE WINGMAN HD

Your Wingman HD is powered by built in lithium-ion, rechargable battery and can be charged through any standard USB port (laptop computer) or with an AC adapter (not included).

- 1. Remove the rubber cover the USB-C charging port on the device.
- 2. Insert the small end (USB-C) of the provided charging cable into the device's charging port.
- 3. Plug the large end (USB-A) of the cable into a power source, such as a laptop/ computer USB port or an AC adapter (minimum 5V/2A).
- 4. Leave connected for 3-5 hours, or until the device is fully charged.
- 5. As device charges the ring indicator will flash.
- 6. When fully charged the entire ring will be solid green.





BITE MAGNETIC MOUNT

The Wingman HD features a powerful BITE magnet incorporated into its housing, which allows the device to be securely attached to a golf cart bar or frame.

CLEANING AND GENERAL CARE

Follow these tips for proper cleaning and maintenance:

- Blow away any excess dust or debris on exterior (or use a soft brush).
- To remove dirt or finger prints, clean with a micro-fiber cloth. The Wingman HD is water resistant, but should not be exposed to heavy rain or other direct streams of water, and will not withstand submersion in water or other liquids.
- When you are not using the speaker, please store it in a secure, dry indoor location for additional protection.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Never disassemble your Wingman HD speaker. Irreparable damage can result from unauthorized service attempts, which also void the warranty.

If unit does not turn on:

- Press Power button fully.
- Charge internal battery. If unit does not respond to power button after fully charging, contact Bushnell Golf customer service: Bushnell Golf Customer Support Link or call (800) 423-3537.

If unit powers down during use:

The battery charge level is low, indicated by a flashing orange Indicator Ring. Recharge the battery.

Problems pairing with phone via Bluetooth:

- The Speaker is within 10m from the device.
- The Speaker is in pairing mode, the LED indicator blinking orange.

No Sound:

- Make sure the music volume is at audible level on both your device and speaker.
- Make sure your device is successfully paired with the speaker.

Poor sound quality:

Move the device closer to the Wingman HD or remove any obstacle between them.

Buttons do not function:

If necessary, the Wingman HD can be reset. Make sure the charging cable is not connected. Place a small pin (<3mm) into the reset key (small opening to the right of the USB charging port) and hold it down (press lightly) for 2 seconds until the LED Indicator Ring turns off.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

How can the user keep the Wingman HD screen protected?

- The Wingman HD features a bright, high-quality display. Similar to a mobile phone, it can generate heat-especially in direct sunlight. For the best performance and longevity, try to keep the screen shaded whenever possible.
- If the Wingman HD does get too warm, you'll see an on-screen prompt reminding you to move it out of direct sunlight so it can cool down.



How should I charge my Wingman HD?

Refer to the full charging instructions on page 10. Use the included charging cable and connect it to a reliable USB power source.

What's the best way to charge the Wingman HD quickly?

For faster charging, use a 5V/2A power adapter or a USB 3.0 port.

Can other chargers be used to charge the Wingman HD Speaker?

Yes, most standard USB power sources will work, but charging times may vary depending on the output.

Can the Wingman HD Speaker charge other devices?

Yes, the Wingman HD Speaker can charge other devices using USB-A input; however, this will reduce the battery charge on the Wingman HD.

CAUTION:

- Keep the speaker and its accessories away from the reach of children, as they might cause a choking hazard.
- Keep the speaker away from fire, water, liquids, extreme heat and strong magnetic fields.




